

## **The Nanaimo Brain Injury Society.**

### **The Society Act.**

#### **Constitution.**

1. The name of the Society is: The Nanaimo Brain Injury Society (formerly Mid-Island Head Injury Support Society).
  
2. The purposes of the society are:
  - (a) To provide and assist those with head injuries and their families and friends;
  - (b) To assist in the on-going rehabilitation of persons with head injuries;
  - (c) To develop human and financial resources in the interests of educational programs and research with respect to persons suffering from head injuries;
  - (d) To promote and implement community head injured education programs in cooperation with health and community programs;
  - (e) To develop and support volunteer activities related to the head injured.
  
3. Upon the winding up of the Society, any funds of the Society remaining after the satisfaction of its debts and liabilities shall be transferred to a charitable organization, charitable corporation, or charitable trust recognized by the Department of National Revenue of Canada as being qualified as such under the provisions of the Income Tax act of Canada from time to time in effect. This provision of the Constitution shall be unalterable.
